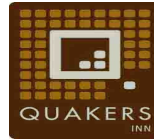

A few house keeping issues regarding registrations and sign on sheets. If players are not listed on sign on sheets

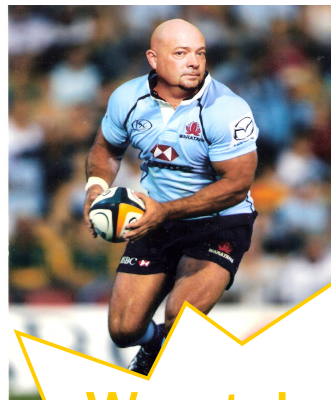
then they **are not** registered. The only exception here are:

- Players playing up an age (this needs to be shown next to their name ie Jack Sparrow (U9s) .
- If the sign on sheet was printed on a Wed and you register the player on Thursday.

Inn this instance send me a note to clarify this. A few teams have been asked to show cause. Remember if it is found that you play unregistered players not only will your team be declared to have forfeited the match but more importantly, no player on the field from either team is covered by insurance. I understand registrars have a lot to do but this needs to be done.
